

HOW TO TURN AN IDEA INTO A STORY

BRAINSTORM LIKE MAD

Pro Tip: Some characters might play two parts. Like a love interest can also be an antagonist.

PONDER YOUR PLOT

While there is no foolproof formula, every story has certain essential elements.

Think about what events might happen in your plot.

Pro Tip: Even if you pre-plot your whole story, stay open to surprise twists and turns as you write.

JUST START WRITING

When all else fails, let the writing do the work. Pick a moment that you know in your story and put some words on the page.

Pro Tip: If you don't know any specific moments, try writing a journal entry for one of your characters.
